Le Piscine Olaiste by Diango Hernández are works that depict places conceived as destinations of pictorial iconographies and will be exhibited at the evocative and panoramic Vista Ostuni.

The project narrates landscapes that belong to the iconography of a renewed Grand Tour of the 21st century.

The pools are imaginary places, yet intentionally real, and belong to that visionary dimension that only such an extraordinary topos can evoke.

Le Piscine Olaiste originated as painted swimming pools and were subsequently transformed into prints, suggesting through Diango Hernández's distinctive pictorial technique, a suspended moment in time: a place imbued with a powerful cinematic atmosphere, inviting us to follow the movement of the water.

A well-known reference to swimming pools comes from cinema, where they emerge as existential spaces - places in which to seek refuge, reflect, and lose oneself: "I'm drifting away... here, in the pool."

For this occasion, a selection of prints and a new painting inspired by the architecture of Vista Ostuni will be presented.

Vista Ostuni is the result of the redevelopment of Ostuni's former Manifattura Tabacchi – a 14th-century building steeped in local history and identity.
